Save the dates - 30 September 2020 and 1 October 2020 - ETUI/ETF /UNI Europa webinar on restructurings

As many sectors and companies are severely hit by COVID-19 pandemic and many restructurings are announced or even in full deployment, ETUI, UNI Europa and ETF will jointly set up two webinars for European Works' Council members + Special Negotiating Body members + EWC Coordinators + national trade union officials on corporate restructuring plans and what the workers' rights are in this situation.

On 30 September 2020 from 10h00 to 12h00 ETUI/ETF/UNI Europa will focus on the theory (legislation & tools) as on the various positions.

On day 2 - 1 October 2020 from 10h00 to 12h00 we will focus on the many case studies and set up a thorough Questions & Answers session.

All sectors are severely hit by COVID-19 pandemic and many companies are filing for bankruptcy or announce large scale restructurings. Some companies use the pandemic as an excuse to push through restructurings. Thanks to the national measures in place in some countries, dismissals are declared illegal whilst workers are furloughed.

This webinar will aim to refresh workers' rights through their EWC's in case of restructuring.
